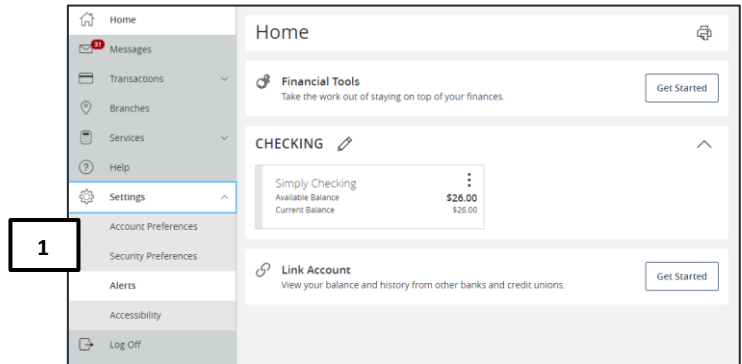
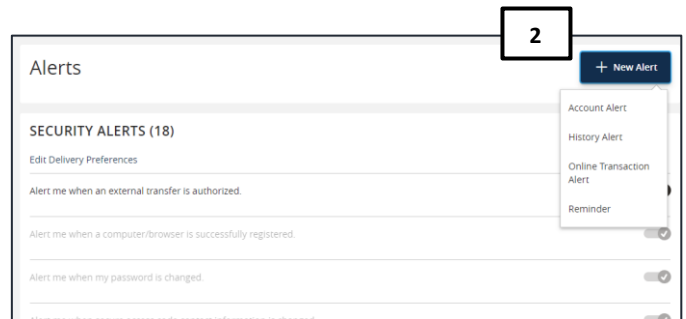


1. Select the 'Settings' menu and then select **Alerts**.

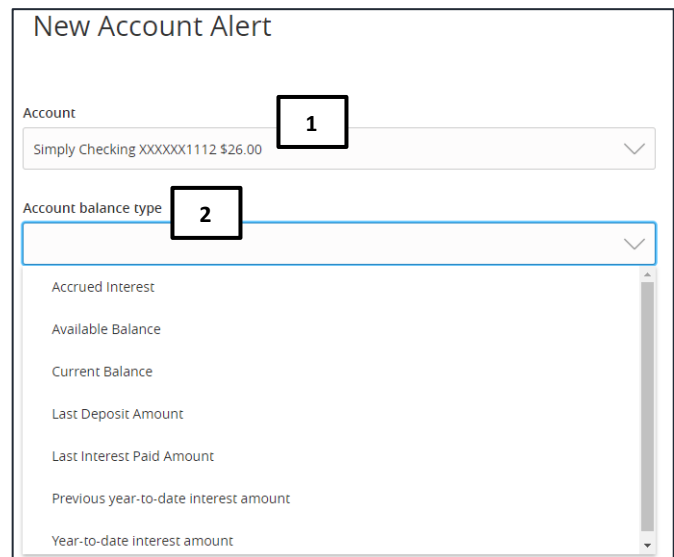


2. Click the **New Alert** button and select the desired type of alert from the drop-down menu.
